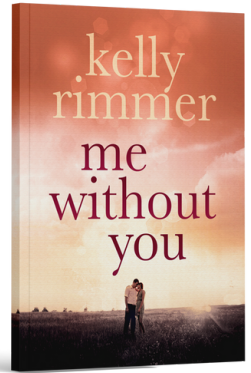
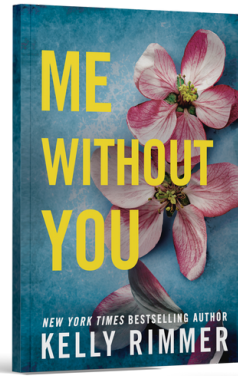


DISCUSSION GUIDE

2. The first and second half of this book have very different tones. Which did you find more interesting? Why?
3. Me Without You is narrated by Callum but the story is also told via Lilah's diary entries – what did you think of this approach? Did you find it confusing to have multiple narrators, or was it necessary?
4. Do you think these characters were reliable narrators?
5. Are there any other characters you would have liked to see tell a part of the story?
6. Did the characters feel realistic to you?
7. Which character/s did you most relate to? Why?
8. Were any characters entirely unlikeable? Was there a villain in this story?
9. What did you think about the discover Cal makes when he notices Lilah's laptop is on at the beach house? Do you think she was wrong to withhold this decision from Cal? Did you think she was wrong to contact his family without his knowledge?
10. Did you think Cal and Lilah's relationship was realistic?
11. Did any particular scenes or specific quotes stand out to you? Why?
12. Were you satisfied with the ending? Did the story end as you expected it would? What would you have changed if you were the author?
13. What did you think about reading a book set in Australia? Did it make it more difficult to imagine the setting?
14. Were you aware of Huntington's Disease before reading this book? Do you think the topic was handled with sufficient sensitivity?
15. Have you read any other books by Kelly Rimmer? If so, how does this one compare? If not, does this book inspire you to read her others?
